OUR MISSION

To provide quality educational opportunities for Monterey County youth.

OUR VISION

Education changes lives. We are committed to funding quality educational programs and awarding scholarships and financial aid to benefit Monterey County students, from pre-kindergarten to postgraduate levels. These funds provide access to opportunities and experiences that deepen, broaden, and expand their world.

In 1975, the Pebble Beach Company Foundation was born with a mission to provide Monterey County's youth with the building blocks of success. In the four decades since our inception, the Foundation has sought meaningful ways to support programs that focus on the educational needs of our community's youth. The needs in Monterey County are great, but the Pebble Beach Company Foundation is working to improve our community by aligning our grant making with the region's best youth-focused nonprofits. To date, the Foundation has reached tens of thousands of children, spent thousands of hours vetting hundreds of grantees, and granted nearly \$9 million in financial support.

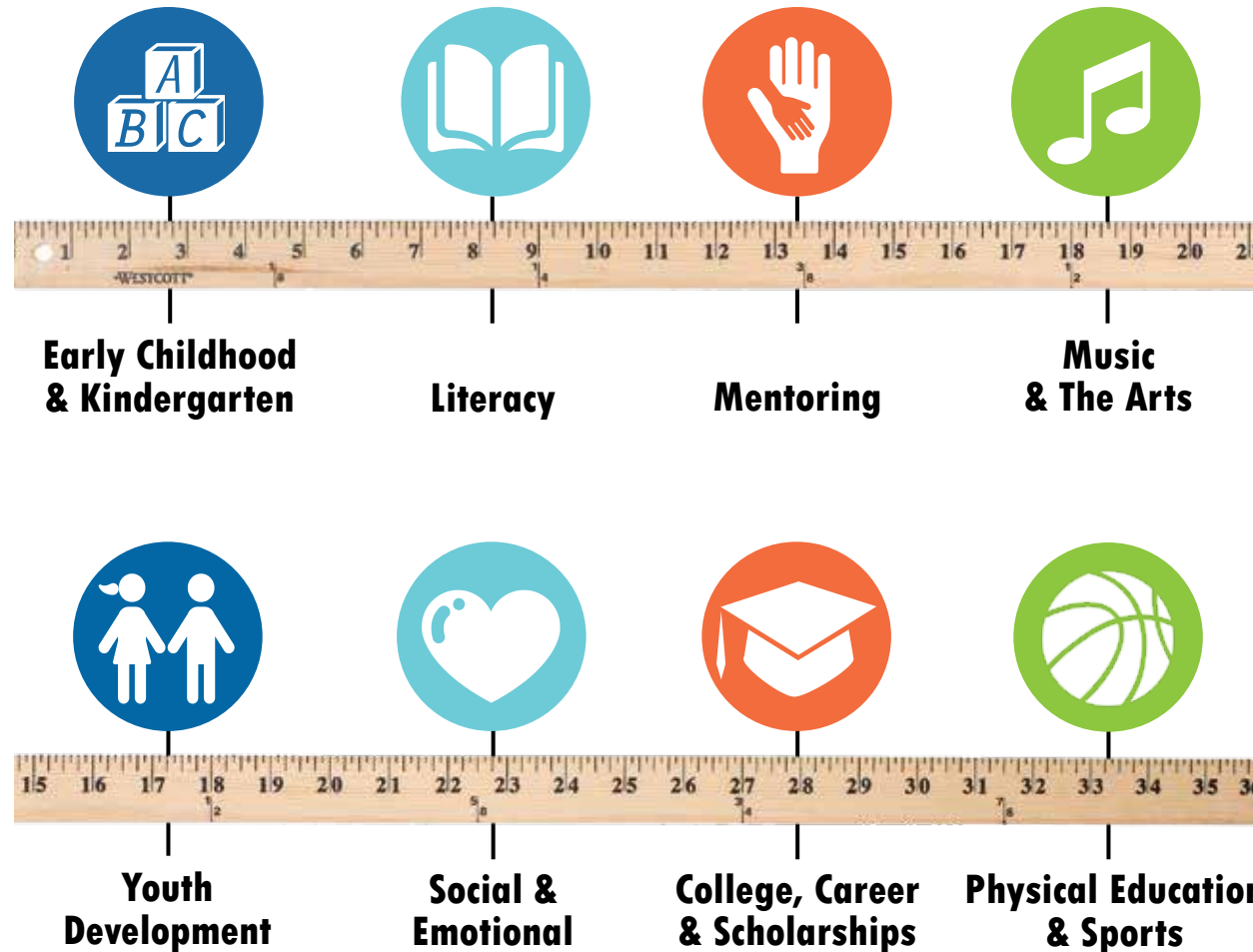

Making a Difference

Meet a few of our partners...



Early Childhood & Kindergarten

Early Learning Center opened its doors in 2018 to over 300 preschoolers ages two to five. Students are offered educational resources that families are unable to provide at home, including an extensive children's library, STEM Early Learning kits, and computer stations. Parents benefit from on-site parenting classes, and their children are better prepared to thrive in kindergarten.

Literacy



The Read to Me Project helps underserved children achieve kindergarten readiness and a lifetime of literacy by empowering school-age brothers and sisters to read to their younger siblings at home. Their team works with 850 students who are reading to 1,000 young family members.

Mentoring



Community Partnership for Youth is a prevention program that provides positive alternatives to gangs, drugs, and violence while reinforcing individual strengths. Over 40 former CPY students serve as mentors to younger children, relating to and addressing each child's needs.

Music & Arts



Sol Treasures provides arts education to south Monterey County schools, located near affordable housing sites and migrant centers. Sol Treasures awakens and nurtures appreciation and passion for the arts by providing after-school art classes, music instruction, and homework assistance for students ages six to eighteen. Two children's theater productions, a middle school band, and youth orchestra are highlights of the program.



Youth Development

Ventana Wilderness Alliance's Youth in Wilderness program provides a positive, immersive introductory experience in nature. Most participants are from underserved communities and have never had the opportunity to hike or camp. Through the program, youth are given the chance to reconnect with themselves, each other and nature, and become lifetime stewards of the environment.

Social & Emotional



Hope, Horses & Kids' talented equine team provides a variety of experiences and activities to a diverse group of children each week. They offer support to individuals with physical disabilities as well as emotional, cognitive, and behavioral challenges—one hoofbeat at a time.

College, Career & Scholarships



Hartnell College Upward Bound provides support to high school students preparing for college matriculation and graduation, all of whom will be first-generation college students. Upward Bound provides comprehensive academic instruction as well as mentoring and college counseling, enrolling 97 percent of its students in colleges.

Physical Education & Sports



Gil Basketball Academy was formed to promote the sport of basketball in east Salinas. The program focuses on the whole child. Youth learn not only the game of basketball, but how to become healthy, productive citizens in their communities. The program improves the confidence of children in the classroom and throughout their daily lives. Strong parental involvement is a key component of the program. Hoopin' for change!

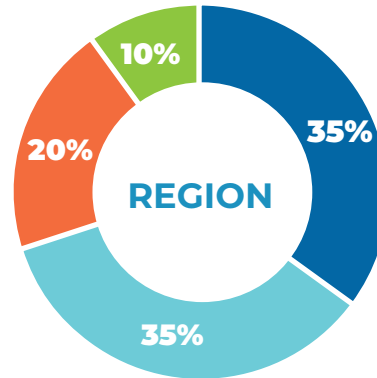

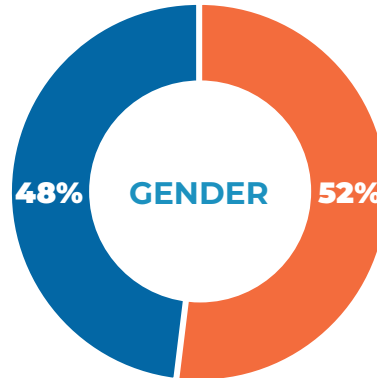

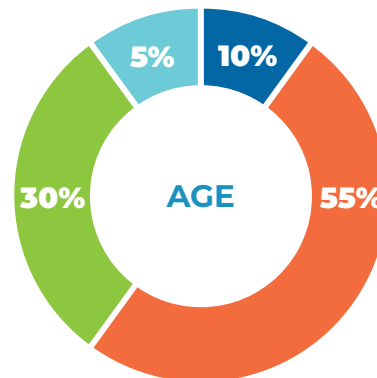

The Scholarship Academy is the signature program of Pebble Beach Company Foundation. It provides broad-based educational assistance through scholarships and financial aid. The Academy focuses on two areas — Community Scholarships and Company Scholarships for children of Pebble Beach Company employees.

Little Free Libraries Project

An exciting recent project of the Foundation is the Little Free Libraries Project supporting Pebble Beach Company Foundation's Youth Literacy Initiative. Little Free Libraries inspire a love of reading, build community, and spark creativity by fostering neighborhood book exchanges around the world. One of the most successful ways to improve the reading achievement of children is to increase their access to books, especially at home. Little Free Libraries play an essential role by providing 24/7 access to books (and encouraging a love of reading) in areas where books are scarce.

There are currently over 75,000 registered Little Free Libraries in 85 countries worldwide, and tens of millions of books are exchanged each year through these Little Free Libraries. Pebble Beach Company Foundation partnered with Rancho Cielo Youth Corps to build Little Free Libraries and place them throughout the community. Each Little Free Library is filled with new books, with an emphasis on diverse children's books for all ages. The Little Free Libraries are located in several locations around the community to promote access to books.

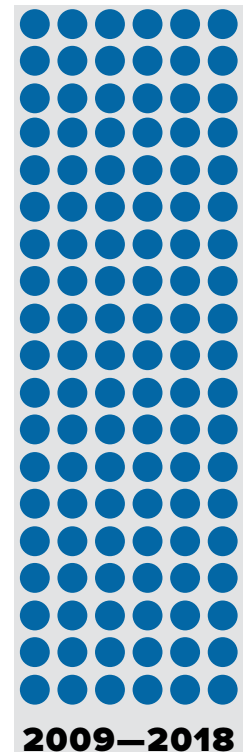

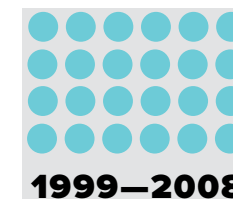

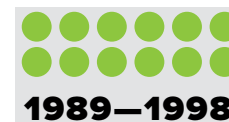
