Climate


- Temperature averages between 45 degrees and 65 degrees annually, with a mean of 56 degrees.
- Average rainfall is 18 inches, occurring primarily between the months of November and April.
- Best weather months are September, October and November.

- Direct air service from Los Angeles and San Francisco.
